We would like to invite you to attend our 'Welcome Induction Evening' on Tuesday 27th June at 6:00pm. This is an information evening for parents of children starting school in September 2023. It will be a chance for you to meet the Foundation Stage teachers, hear about the curriculum and what goes on in Foundation Stage, answer any questions you may have and give you all the information you need to prepare for September. Please note, this session is <u>intended for adults</u> and wouldn't be suitable for children to attend.

Following this event, children will be invited to a 'Stay and Play' session on Wednesday 5th July. This session will be held in two groups, either the morning or the afternoon. This session will last for around 1 and half hours allowing children to visit the Foundation Stage provision with one parent/carer and start to become familiar with the classroom environment. Finally, we will also be planning to conduct home visits for the new cohort of children. These will take place during **weeks beginning 3rd and 10th of July**. The visits are only a short 15-minute meeting with yourself and your child in your own environment. We have learned over several years that these sessions are valuable for us when supporting children starting school.

The home visit sessions will be booked via an online questionnaire where you will be able to give us your availability for that time period and then the Foundation Stage team will schedule an appointment time with you. Further information about this will be sent out to you closer to the time.

I am sure you are starting to think of questions about starting school, please do not worry, the Foundation Stage staff are very experienced at supporting families who have their first child starting school, so be reassured that everything you need to know will be communicated to you before the end of the Summer Term.
