


Map of the World locating Egypt.

Mummification	A way of preserving a body to get it ready for the afterlife.


Gods and Goddesses

Ancient Egypt Timeline

- 3500 BC First use of Hieroglyphics
- 3100 BC Start of ancient Egypt (approximate)
- 2550 BC Pyramids at Giza built
- 1336 BC Tutankhamen becomes pharaoh
- 196 BC Rosetta Stone Carved
- 69 BC Cleopatra rules Egypt
- 30 BC Egypt becomes a Roman province
- 1922 AD Carter discovers Tutankhamen's tomb
