Create a mind map of all the information you already know about the Antarctica. Next, think of 3 questions that you would like to research about the Antarctica and add these to your mind map.	Find out about the animals that live there such as the different types of Penguins and Whales and create some drawings and Funky Facts about these.	Make some simple comparisons using Venn diagrams and drawings to show some differences and similarities between the UK and Antarctic.
